[The NCC Thanks Senate for Introducing Title VIII Reauthorization \(S.1399\)](#)

On June 5, ALL 62 members of the Nursing Community Coalition signed onto a letter to Senators Merkley and Burr for introducing [S. 1399](#), Title VIII Nursing Workforce Reauthorization Act of 2019. This overwhelming support from the NCC has also been seen in additional outreach to support the House companion bill ([H.R. 728](#)), which now has 109 bipartisan cosponsors! This is five more cosponsors than when it passed last Congress. The NCC will continue outreach on this essential legislation.

[NCC Commends House for Passing FY 2020 LHHS-ED Minibus](#)

On June 19, the Nursing Community Coalition released a statement commending the House of Representatives for passing [H.R. 2740](#), the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act of 2020, which increases investments in nursing education and research. H.R. 2740 would appropriate:

- **\$279.472 million for Title VIII Nursing Workforce Development Programs:** This is a \$30.000 million (12.03%) increase over FY 2019 funding levels and includes \$10 million for existing Title VIII programs and \$20 million in grants for optional community-based nurse practitioner fellowship programs.
- **\$170.958 million for National Institute of Nursing Research (NINR):** This is a \$7.966 million and 4.89% increase over FY 2019 funding levels.

The NCC looks forward to working with the Senate as the appropriation process continues.
